Paragraphs justified, with single-line spacing and with 0 pts spacing before/after paragraphs. **Material and Methods.** The abstract text should not exceed 250 words. No figures or tables. Incorrect formatting may result in your abstract being returned to you for corrections.

**Results.** The Scientific Committee will evaluate the abstracts and will confirm the type of presentation and scientific theme and/or session retained. Of note, posters will be on display on a schedule on all meeting days.

**Conclusion.** The congress official language is English. Please submit your abstract accordingly. Abstracts must be submitted online via the website only. Abstracts submitted by email will not be accepted. Abstracts must be received by the announced deadline. Abstracts received after the deadline will not be considered. The submitted version of the abstract will be the final one, subsequent changes will not be possible.
